

## SECONDARY TERTIARY PATHWAYS



CBHS offers students in Year 12 and 13 the exciting opportunity to kick-start their career towards a vocational qualification. CBHS's Secondary Tertiary Pathways keep students engaged in education as they transition from a secondary to a tertiary environment or employment, and provide the opportunity to gain NCEA Level 1-3 and a tertiary qualification.

### Learning

Learning will focus on relevant skills and industry-based training that leads to employment, apprenticeship opportunities or further tertiary-level study. Students will still get to take part in school sports and clubs and catch up with friends at school. Having access to both school and tertiary support services also helps with a smoother transition into the workplace or education beyond school.

### This option is perfect for students who . . .

- Want an alternative to traditional secondary and tertiary education.
- Are looking for something hands-on, practical and relevant to an industry or profession.
- Want a qualification that gives you skills and strengths employers are looking for.
- Want to obtain NCEA credits for real-world career training.

### **What can I study?**

You will attend CBHS Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday completing a set course of work and you will attend a local tertiary provider Thursday and Friday to study for your vocational qualification.

Secondary Tertiary Pathways students can partake in skills-based training in the following areas:

- Agriculture and Horticulture
- Education and Sustainability
- Engineering and Architecture
- Trades
- Food and Hospitality
- Health and Science
- Tourism, Retail, Hair and Beauty

*(The list above is subject to change due to changes in government funding allocations)*

### **Practical hands-on learning**

Students learn the foundation skills relevant to their chosen career path in a practical hands-on learning environment using industry standard equipment and technology.

Benefits:

- A fees-free tertiary education
- A head start on a trades career while still at school and while achieving NCEA
- Study at CBHS Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and at a tertiary provider Thursday and Friday
- More choices for students to include vocational pathways in their study options
- Gain work experience – links with local industry
- ‘Work-Ready’ young people
- Enrol into further study after successful completion.

### **Entry criteria**

- You must be a motivated Year 12–13 CBHS student
- You need to be keen to pursue a career pathway related to the programme
- Ideally you should have achieved NCEA Level 1 including English and Maths or be working towards it (however exceptions may be made in some circumstances).
- Meet the entry criteria set by the tertiary provider and attend an interview
