

HOCKEY

Hockey began at Christchurch Boys' High in 1940. It has been the schools most successful sport since then with the 1st XI winning the National Secondary School Hockey Title – The Rankin Cup 18 times since 1960.

The Rankin Cup is the symbol of supremacy in NZ secondary school hockey. Since 1960 the 1st XI has finished in the top 8 on 57 times, including 1st: 18 times, 2nd: 2 times, 3rd: 6 times.

The 1st XI has also won four other tournaments since 1960 winning the India Shield twice and the Johnson Cup twice. The only school to match this performance is Auckland Grammar.

The school has now produced 31 New Zealand players including four players and the coach for the Gold Medal winning Montreal Olympic Team in 1976.

The 1st XI has won the Rankin Cup in every decade since 1960 with the last win being in 2010.

2017 SEASON

Dates: Games start May through to August (Terms 2 &3). Trials are at the

Tournaments: Rankin Cup which is held every year during winter tournament week
