INTRODUCTION

This course is primarily for students who have experienced difficulty with English at the junior school level. The course establishes confidence and competence through concentrating on practical and everyday language skills rather than literature. The course covers the requirements for Level 1 literacy.

CONTENT

The course emphasises practical communication skills. It reinforces and builds on previously acquired skills in reading, writing, speaking and listening, presenting and viewing. A selection from the Standards listed below will be offered.

Between 8 and 11 Level 1 English credits and Level 1 Literacy and at the discretion of the HOD. Students who gain less than eight English credits or have not gained Level 1 Literacy are required to complete Year 11 English.

INTRODUCTION

The intention is to provide a high-interest course based on carefully-selected resources and tasks involving reading and writing. The course aims to provide an

avenue for boys who will generally not be studying English at university but who intend to gain the literacy requirement for University Entrance in order to study other tertiary subjects.

CONTENT AND SKILLS
